General Instructions

Read all instructions before cutting or sewing.

Pre-wash and press all fabrics before cutting.

Use 1/4" seam allowance.

Cutting instructions

A = Style # 120-5952 For side borders cut (2) 5 1/2" x 38" strips along the length of fabric *and*
for top and bottom borders cut (4) 5 1/2" x 31" strips across remaining width.
From remaining fabric : Cut (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares *and*
Cut (16) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares *and*
Cut (16) 1 3/4" x 3" strips

Cutting Instructions continued

B = Style #120-5951 For side borders cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strips *and*

for top and bottom borders cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strips *and*

cut (5) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares *and*

cut (20) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares *and*

cut (20) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" strips.

C = Style #120-5982 For side borders cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strips *and*

for top and bottom borders cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " strips *and*

cut (10) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares then sub-cut into (20) half square triangles *and*

for binding cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

D = Style #120-5991 Cut (16) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares then sub-cut into (32) half square triangles.

E = Style #120-5971 For side borders cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strips *and*

for top and bottom borders cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " *and*

cut (20) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

F = Style #120-6011 Cut (40) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares *and*

cut (8) 3" x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " strips.

G = Style #120-5981 Cut (8) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares then sub-cut into (16) half square triangles *and*

cut (18) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" strips.

H = Style #120-5992 Cut (16) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

I = Style #120-6022 Cut (10) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares and then sub-cut into (20) half square triangles

J = Style #120-6021 Cut (16) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

K = Style #120-5962 Cut (10) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares and then sub-cut into (20) half square triangles.

L = Style #120-6001 Cut (20) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

M = Style #120-5972 Cut (16) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

N = Style #120-6002 Cut (10) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" strips.

O = Style #120-5961 Cut (16) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

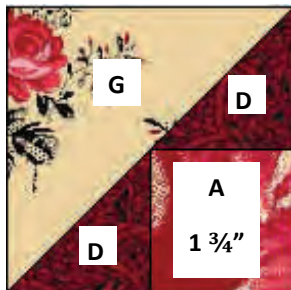
Sewing instructions

Make (4) 10 ½" x 10 ½" dark blocks.

1. To make the 4 dark blocks sew the following units.
2. Assemble the units into blocks using the block diagram below.
3. Press all seam allowances as you sew .

Sewing construction continued

Make (5) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" light blocks.

1. To make the 5 light blocks sew the following units.
2. Sew the units into blocks following the diagram below.
3. Press all seam allowances as you sew.

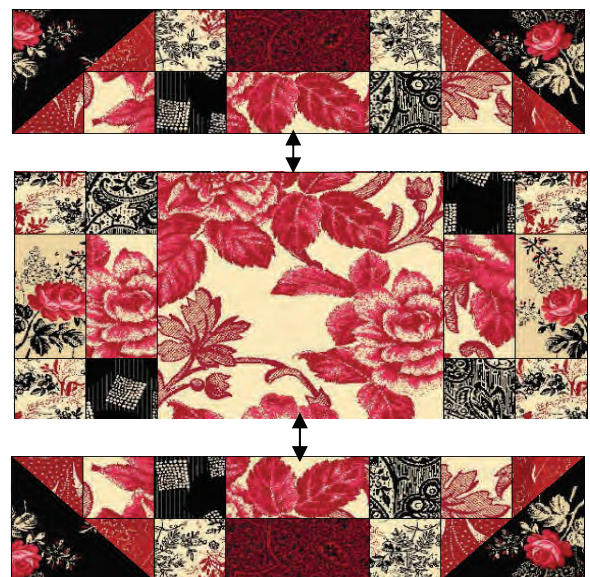
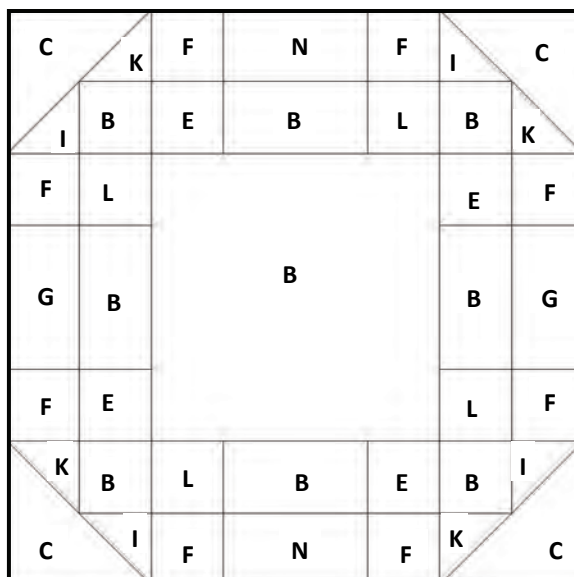

Assembly

1. Trim all blocks to 10 ½" square.
2. Layout blocks in rows: 3 across and 3 down, alternating light and dark blocks with a light block in the center.
3. Sew blocks together and press entire quilt.

Borders

Press all seam allowances toward outside edge of quilt on borders as you sew them on.

Refer to border diagram below.

1. Sew side borders E onto each side of quilt.
2. Sew top and bottom borders E onto quilt
3. Sew side borders B to each side of quilt.
4. Sew top and bottom borders B onto quilt.
5. Sew side borders C onto each side of quilt.
6. Sew top and bottom C borders onto quilt.
7. Sew side borders A onto each side of quilt.
8. Remove any selvedge edges and sew 2 A 5 ½" x 31 ½" strips end to end for each of the top and bottom A borders. Press seam allowance flat. Trim to 48½".
9. Sew top and bottom borders A onto quilt.
10. Press entire quilt.
11. Layer with backing of your choice and batting.
12. Bind with fabric C.
